The Green New Deal for Europe (tweet)storms the European Parliament!

Opposed to the "Green Deal" by the European Commission, which is neither new or green, our <u>Green New Deal for Europe</u> promises to establish fairness, economic justice and sustainability to our continent - and the world.

Europe is a global driver of environmental breakdown. This is why we should lead by example to reverse that. While there are efforts underway to address this issue, such as the Green Deal by the European Commission, those contributions are not enough to tackle any of the crises facing humanity: environmental, economic or the decline of democracy. Activists across the continent (Greta included!) agree that ideas purported by Governments are insufficient.

Our <u>Blueprint for Europe's Just Transition</u> offers European leaders, activists and communities a comprehensive — and realistic — plan for the continent to meet the scale of the historic challenge ahead. Calibrated in the right way and implemented with urgency, the policies proposed in our paper could see Europe reach net-zero CO2 emissions within 5 years — a target that is consistent with the principle of equity as embodied in the "common but differentiated responsibility" clause in the Paris framework. Given Europe's greater responsibility for historical emissions and greater technological and financial capacity, it must lead the way.
